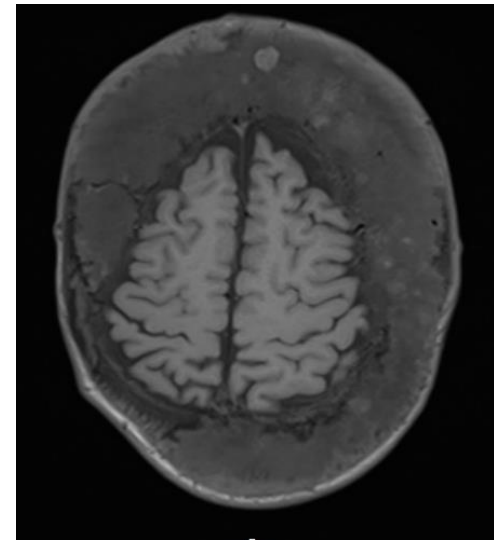


Figure 2 - Polyostotic fibrous dysplasia. Axial T1 – weighted.

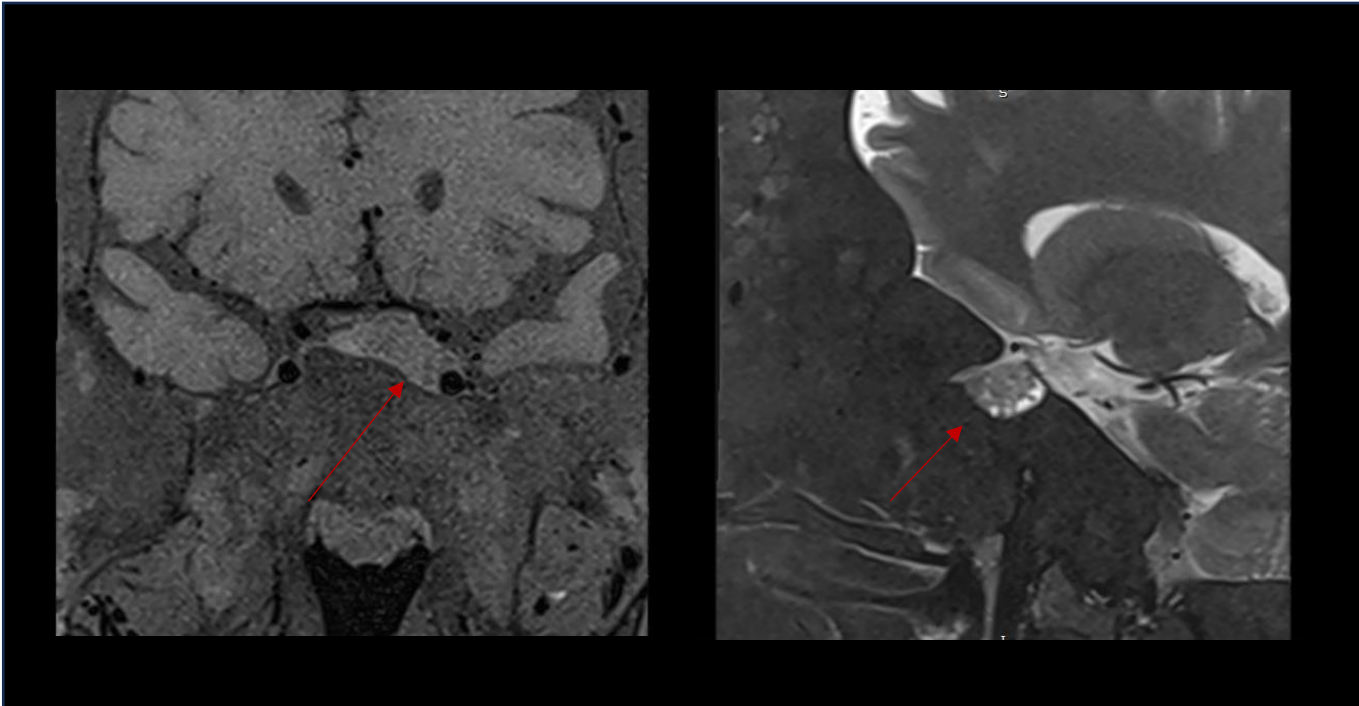


Figure 3 - MRI images T1 and T2-weighted illustrate a pituitary macroadenoma touching the optic chiasm (left side). Coronal T1 and Sagittal T2-weighted MR.
